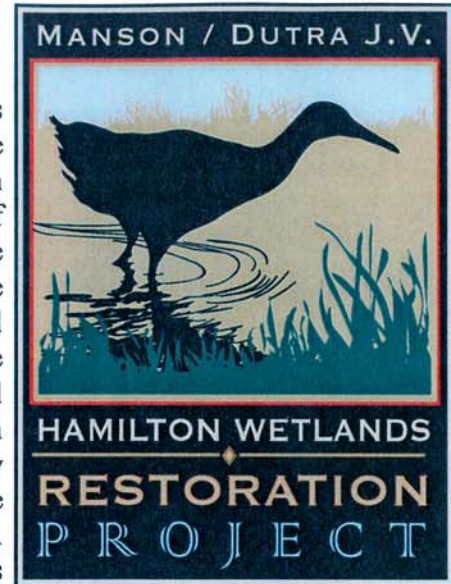


Dear Residents,

Manson/Dutra J.V. and the US Army Corps of Engineers would like to inform residents about current and future construction activities occurring at the former Hamilton Airfield. The airfield has been divided into a number of separate cells that will be filled sequentially. The cell at the NW end of the runway is currently being filled. You can see this cell highlighted in yellow on the map. There is a cell (shown in red) adjacent to the Hangars that will be filled in the near future. Heavy equipment will be operating in this cell while it is being filled from 7am-10pm Monday through Saturday. Manson/Dutra J.V. and the C.O.E. are continuously working toward minimizing disturbances to residents from the operation of heavy equipment and lights at night. A professional third-party firm will be monitoring noise levels continuously and providing feedback for improvement. During cell filling activities, potentially dangerous marshland is created. This may create a serious hazard to humans and pets. All levees and cells are strictly off limits to non construction personnel and pets.
